

<u>The Problem</u>



Organisations and networks run by Deaf or Disabled people have many different people.

They have lots of different skills and talents.



Deaf and Disabled people are staff, trustees, volunteers, members, and activists.

They care a lot about things that need to be better.



Deaf and Disabled people often have ideas to make things better.

But they do not get to lead very much.

This is because they face obstacles and discrimination.

Our Answer



We wanted to change this. So, we made a leadership programme.

This helps Deaf and Disabled people become confident leaders.

New leaders learn by doing things.



Our programme gives you the chance to lead a project.

This project will be about a change you want in your organisation or community.



We help you grow personally. We help you find out what problems made leadership hard before.


What happens on the programme



October-November 2023 The First Steps

We will meet three times face-toface.

We will learn different ways to solve problems and deal with changes.



December 2023-September 2024 Learning by Doing

We will help you pick a project that you really want to do.

It will be something you care about in your group or community.

You'll work on this during the whole programme.



December 2023-September 2024 Monthly Meetups and Growing Together

All of us in the program will meet once a month.

Sometimes in person, sometimes online.

We will make sure it is a safe, brave place to learn.



We will come up with ideas together and learn how to solve problems.

We will share what we have learned and practice using our problem-solving tools together.



We will talk about what's hard and what's going well.

In the past programmes, many people made new friendships.

What projects have people led before?



One person made her theatre group bigger.

This group gives Disabled people space to talk about things that matter to them.



Another person became much more confident.

They became a leader for a BAME sight committee.



Two people started new social activities.

These activities are run by and for adults with learning difficulties.

Making sure you can do well



Making sure your needs are met.

From the start, we will help you understand each other's needs.

We will do more than just the usual support.

We want to make sure everyone feels comfortable.

You'll have regular coaching sessions.




You will have meetings, usually online, with a coach.

We want to help you be proud and confident of your strengths and experiences.

We will help solve things that could stop you from reaching your goals.

Help for your group or network



We know joining this program can affect your organisation or network.

You will need some time away from your usual work or volunteering.



You might choose to do a project that changes something in your organisation.



Your coach will meet with you and your organisation twice during the programme.

They will help solve any problems.



We also offer £1000 to your organisation to cover costs.

There is another £1000 for any extra training costs for your project.

You must be a Deaf or Disabled person.

We're looking for 10 people to join us.




We know some Deaf or Disabled people experience other kinds of discrimination, too.
